

IGA Supermarkets \$160,000 Spring Clean Out Promotion 2010

Acceptance by you

1. The IGA Supermarkets \$160,000 Spring Clean Out promotion ("the competition") is provided by IGA Distribution Pty Ltd ABN 67 004 391 422 of 50 Waterloo Road, Macquarie Park NSW 2113 ("the Promoter"). These conditions (including without limitation the information on how to enter and prize details which we publish in relation to the competition) apply to the competition. You, acknowledge that you have read and understood, and agree to be bound by these conditions.

IF YOU DO NOT ACCEPT THESE CONDITIONS YOU MUST NOT ENTER THE COMPETITION.

Entering the competition

2. The competition runs from Monday 16 August 2010 at 12:01am Australian Eastern Standard Time AEST until Monday 27 September 2010 at 11:59pm AEST ("Promotional Period").
3. Entry is only open to residents of Australia, except Tasmanian residents. Employees and their families of the Promoter, participating IGA stores and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.
4. If you are aged under 18, you must seek the consent of your parent or legal guardian before entering this competition.
5. To enter and be eligible to win, entrants must, during the Promotion Period, purchase any Ambi-Pur, Duck, Glade, Finish, Napisan, Omo, Ajax, White King or Pine O Clean product ("Eligible Products") with a severable barcode (ie not canned products) from a participating IGA store, fully and correctly complete an original official entry form, attach one original barcode cut out from any of the Eligible Products and post together to "IGA \$160,000 Spring Clean Promotion" PO Box 537, Eastern Suburbs MC NSW 2004.
6. Multiple entries accepted, however, each entry must be submitted on a separate entry form in accordance with entry requirements and must include one original barcode and an official original entry form. Prizes

7. There are 74 prizes to be won. A computerised electronic prize draw will take place at 11am AEST at Salmat Interactive, Innovation Place Level 17, 100 Arthur Street, North Sydney, NSW 2060 on Thursday 30th September 2010.
8. The first entry drawn will win a Hyundai Automatic i45 Elite 2.4i GDI 4 Door Sedan Car. This prize includes all compulsory insurances and registration. 24. Our liability in relation to the goods we supply is limited to our option to: a) replacement of the goods or the supply of equivalent goods; or b) repair of the goods; or c) payment of the cost of replacing the goods or of acquiring equivalent goods; or d) payment of the cost of having the goods repaired; and our liability in relation to services we supply, is limited to our option to: a) the supplying of the services against; or b) the payment of the cost of having the services supplied again.

Termination

27. We may terminate or cancel your entry in the competition immediately in our reasonable discretion or if you breach any of your obligations under these conditions.

Failure to comply and severability

30. We are not liable for any failure to comply with these conditions. If any part or provision in these conditions is found to be invalid, unenforceable or illegal for any reason, that part or provision shall be severed and the remaining provisions shall continue in full force.

Entire agreement and governing law

31. These conditions constitute the entire agreement between us and us as to its subject matter. By entering the competition, you accept that this agreement is to be interpreted, and any disputes are to be determined by the courts having jurisdiction in New South Wales, in accordance with the laws in force in New South Wales from time to time.
